- After graduation Ruben hopes to become a student-athlete academic advisor for a Division I institution in Southern California.



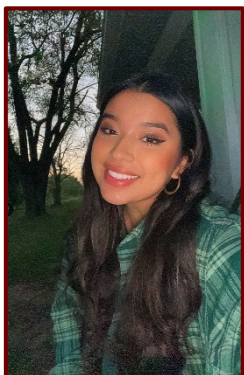
Rachel Weaver
